Point of View

FIRST PERSON

me we my us

A (haracter is telling the story.

"I went to the store to get cheese."

(told from a first-hand account)

2nd Person: usually found in letters, instructions, and technical writing.

SECOND PERSON - | you

The narrator addresses the reader. (not often used in narratives or fictional stories) "First, you must go to the store."

THIRD PERSON

he she it him his her

A **narrator** is telling the story.

"He went to the store to get cheese."
